According to its current owner, this John Deere AR was found in Northeast Finney County, Kansas. It had mainly been used to seed grass along the highways.

Restoration of the classic included repairing the water pump, installing new batteries, changing the oil and filter, changing the rear end oil, repairing the start, cleaning the tin and painting the tractor.

This tractor features a hydraulic system that was added to the tractor. It is not "factory," as it runs off of the PTO.

The "AR" was the "regular" or fixed-tread version of the model "A." The series also included the "AO" orchard version and the "AI" industrial model. The tractors were produced in John Deere's Waterloo, Iowa, factory from 1935 to 1952.
