This 730 LP Standard is one of only 220 built by John Deere. It was originally shipped new to Winfield, Kansas. Three years ago, the current owner purchased it in Wichita, Kansas.

It is entirely original except for the new rear tires and rims which were replaced due to calcium erosion. It has been used to plow over the past few years. The current owner reports that the tractor is in excellent condition, runs great and has 2,585 hours.

The 30 series was the last run of the world-famous John Deere two-cylinders and was hugely popular. It was introduced in 1958, built until 1961 and was known for its modern look, yellow striping, instrumentation and fenders with headlights on the row-crops.
