This 1964 Schafer PS 154 is believed to be one of fewer than 25 total tractors ever produced by Schafer Plow, Inc. - a Pratt, Kansas, company. It is also believed to be one of only three produced with a factory cab.

It was purchased new from Western Tractor, Inc., in Kansas City for \$19,500 after Western Tractor acquired Schafer's remaining production, and was used to farm a 320-acre wheat farm in Mitchell County, Kansas.

The tractor features an Allis-Chalmers engine, Roadranger transmission and Dana-Spicer clutch. It has Rockwell planetary, final drives and front brakes and coordinated or crab steering.

The precise hours on the machine are unknown, but it is believed to be less than 2,000 hours. The hour meter was unhooked after learning the mechanism that drove the meter had the potential to cause damage to the machine.

The tractor is completely original both inside and out, except that one pair of tires have been replaced and occasional touch-up paint applied. It has not been completely repainted. It has been stored in an insulated shed.

This tractor has been featured twice on the covers of Fastline.
